Your prescription will be ready for collection the following month (except on a Saturday, Sunday, or bank holiday).

A member of the Dispensary Team will inform you of the collection date.

PLEASE NOTE:

Only regular repeat medications can be ordered using this system.

If you are due to go on holiday and need your repeats earlier, please tell a member of the Dispensary Team.

Patient confidentiality is important to us, your repeat slip contains demographic information and details about your medication, if a representative is collecting on your behalf you have consented to this information being available to this individual.

Stock Availability

There are many reasons why we are sometimes unable to obtain stock from our suppliers, some examples are...

- Manufacturing issues
- Recall of a product
- Changes to packaging and/or patient information leaflet's
- Failed deliveries

We do our best to find alternatives to prescribed items and to obtain the items from our four different suppliers, in most cases supply issues are out of our control so we may offer you the option to try and obtain an item from an alternative Pharmacy.

We are reluctant to send you elsewhere as the Dispensary creates income for the practice to offer the services we provide to our patients.

Prescription Charges (May 2024)

In order to reduce wastage NHS England advises that only 28 days supply of medication is issued per month.

Online Pharmacies such as Pharmacy2U are not part of the NHS and are not connected to the practice. If you opt in to having your prescriptions electronically sent to an alternative Pharmacy, ALL of your prescriptions including Urgent medications will be sent via the electronic system.
