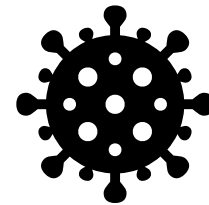

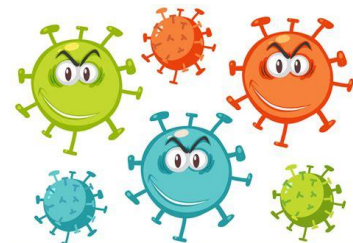

### Dispensary Vending Machine

Here at Staunton and Corse Surgery we pride ourselves on innovation and providing our patients with excellent service, with this in mind...in the very near future we will be having a Prescription Collection vending machine installed at the practice.

The vending machine will be accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week for the collection of prescriptions, this will exclude fridge lines and controlled drugs.

Adequate time is needed to allow our Nursing Team to evaluate the treatment you require in line with travel guidance.
